

Powder Diffraction Journal and Bibliographic Update

Powder Diffraction journal (PDJ) is entering into its fifth year with Cambridge University Press as our publisher. In 2017, they introduced Cambridge Core: <https://www.cambridge.org/core/journals/powder-diffraction> where a digital form of PDJ is accessible to subscribers and individual article purchasers. This year we expect to publish both the European Powder Diffraction Conference (EPDIC15) and Australian X-ray Analytical Association (AXAA2017) Proceedings. AXA papers will also be highlighted in the June issue. Institutional print and online (bundle) subscribers will also have access to the digital version of AXA posted on the ICDD website: (http://www.icdd.com/resources/axasearch/search_based_on_vol.asp). Bibliographic efforts include new databases added onto the Scientific and Technical Information Network (STN) platform, as well as incorporating results more seamlessly from Google Scholar. Duplicate results are filtered with the aid of Excel and in house database import software. Nearly 6000 total results were received from STN that include journal articles, conference papers, dissertations and patents.
