Advanced Tools for e-Learning (ATeL) was tested during the XRD I clinic in 2018 in the hopes that it would improve the PDF-4+ database training. T. Blanton found that there were mixed opinions on ATeL from the attendees and it looks like the benefit will be primarily for isolated sites. There is a possibility of ICDD distributing it for a small fee, but it really needs to be part of a larger program. ICDD is not going to work with the program further, until we know what our online educational activities will look like. T. Blanton commented, we have been working on putting some additional content on our website for educational applications. We do have some initial videos helping people with installation issues and application uses. We are in the process of getting some translations together as well. These videos are available on the ICDD website, as well as YouTube, so they can be searched.

7. New Business

Earlier in the week C. Segre and M. Leoni had a conversation about how since our Subcommittee is very large and not as many people attend the meetings, we'd like to do a survey of our membership on how crystallography is taught at various educational institutions. Basically start with the membership, ask where and how crystallography or fluorescence is taught. It might help us make a decision regarding what is being taught here at the clinics.



10 Year Look at Clinic Attendance






